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Your prescription drug plan also includes:

- Diabetic supplies
- \$25 copay maximum per fill per 30 day supply for formulary insulin drugs and \$35 copay maximum per fill per 30 day supply for non-formulary insulin drugs; no deductible for insulin drugs
- \$25 copay maximum per fill per 30-day supply for formulary epinephrine and \$50 copay maximum per fill per 30-day supply for asthma inhaler
- No deductible for asthma inhaler
- Sexual dysfunction drugs, including daily dose, additional 6 tablets a month for erectile dysfunction
- A limited list of over-the-counter medications when filled with a prescription

Family planning

- Oral and injectable fertility drugs included (physician charges for injections are not covered under RX, medical coverage is limited).
- Contraceptives covered up to a 12-month supply. Contraceptive copay strategy applies.

The following are covered 100% in-network:

- Oral chemotherapy drugs
 - Seasonal vaccinations
 - Preventive vaccinations
 - Affordable Care Act (ACA) eligible preventive medications and contraceptives, also includes male condoms

Precertification requirements

Some covered prescription drugs need approval from us before we will cover the drug.

Some covered prescription drugs require step therapy before we cover them. With step therapy, you must first try one or more drugs before we will pay for drugs that require step therapy.

To get the most up-to-date precertification requirements and a list of drugs that require step therapy, see your plan documents or go online to your member website.

Choose generics with dispense as written (DAW) override - Sometimes your physician may say you need a brand-name prescription drug even if a generic is available. If so, you will pay the brand-name copay. If you ask for a brand-name prescription drug when a generic is available, you will pay the applicable brand-name copay plus the difference between the generic price and the brand-name price.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Dependents who are eligible to be on your plan Spouse, children from birth to age 26. Student status of children does not matter.

**We cover the cost of services based on whether doctors are "in network" or "out of network." We want to help you understand how much we pay for your out-of-network care. At the same time, we want to make it clear how much more you will need to pay for this "out-of-network" care.

You may choose a provider (doctor or hospital) in our network. You may choose to visit an out-of-network provider. If you choose a doctor who is out of network, your health plan may pay some of that doctor's bill. Most of the time, you will pay a lot more money out of your own pocket if you choose to use an out-of-network doctor or hospital.

When you choose out-of-network care, we limit the amount it will pay. This limit is called the "recognized" or "allowed" amount.

- For doctors and other professionals the amount is based on what Medicare pays for these services. The government sets the Medicare rate. Exactly how much we "recognize" depends on the plan you or your employer picks.

- For hospitals and other facilities, the amount is based on what Medicare pays for these services. The government sets the Medicare rate. Exactly how much we "recognize" depends on the plan you or your employer picks.



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Your doctor sets his or her own rate to charge you. It may be higher -- sometimes much higher -- than what your plan "recognizes." Your doctor may bill you for the dollar amount that we don't "recognize." You must also pay any copayments, coinsurance and deductibles under your plan. No dollar amount above the "recognized charge" counts toward your deductible or out-of-pocket maximums. To learn more about how we pay out-of-network benefits visit our website.

You can avoid these extra costs by getting your care from Aetna's broad network of health care providers. Go to www.aetna.com and click on "Find a Doctor" on the left side of the page. If you are already a member, sign on to your Navigator member site.

This applies when you choose to get care out of network. When you have no choice (for example: emergency room visit after a car accident, or for other emergency services), we will pay the bill as if you got care in network. You pay cost sharing and deductibles for your in-network level of benefits. Contact us if your provider asks you to pay more. You are not responsible for any outstanding balance billed by your providers for emergency services beyond your cost sharing and deductibles.

This way of paying out-of-network doctors and hospitals applies when you choose to get care out of network. When you have no choice (for example: emergency room visit after a car accident), we will pay the bill as if you got care in-network. - All medical and hospital services not specifically covered in, or which are limited or excluded by your plan documents.
- Cosmetic surgery, including breast reduction.
- Custodial care.
- Dental care and dental X-rays.
- Donor egg retrieval
- Experimental and investigational procedures, except for coverage for medically necessary routine patient care costs for members participating in a cancer clinical trial.
- Hearing aids
- Home births
- Immunizations for travel or work, except where medically necessary or indicated.
- Implantable drugs and certain injectable drugs including injectable infertility drugs.
- Infertility services, including artificial insemination and advanced reproductive technologies such as IVF, ZIFT, GIFT, ICSI and other related services, unless specifically listed as covered in your plan documents.
- Long-term rehabilitation therapy.
- Non-medically necessary services or supplies.
- Outpatient prescription drugs (except for treatment of diabetes), unless covered by a prescription plan rider and over-the-counter medications (except as provided in a hospital) and supplies.
- Radial keratotomy or related procedures.
- Reversal of sterilization.
- Services for the treatment of sexual dysfunction/enhancement, including therapy, supplies or counseling or prescription drugs.
- Special duty nursing.
- Therapy or rehabilitation other than those listed as covered.
- Weight control services including surgical procedures, medical treatments, weight control/loss programs, dietary regimens and supplements, appetite suppressants and other medications; food or food supplements, exercise programs, exercise or other equipment; and other services and supplies that are primarily intended to control weight or treat obesity, including Morbid Obesity, or for the purpose of weight reduction, regardless of the existence of comorbid conditions.
